Ages 4–8 · Any reading level

How to use this pack

- Ten weeks, one page each. Every day she reads — or is read to — she fills one sticker square. Being read to counts. It counts the same.
- A sticker square is a square, not a specific sticker. A drawing, a smiley face, a scribble in her favourite colour: all fine.
- Twenty minutes is the target, but a bad day with four minutes still earns the square. The streak is worth more than the stopwatch.
- There is a book list at the back. Writing down a finished book is the part children reread years later.
- Do not turn this into a chore chart. If it starts to feel like homework, put it in a drawer for a week and come back to it.

A note for the grown-up

Short and cheerful beats long and correct. Five to ten focused minutes a day will out-perform a forty-minute session that ends in tears. Stop while she still wants one more page — that is what makes her come back tomorrow. Say the sound, not the letter name, when you are sounding words out.
